With thanks to Cunderdin Quilters" Retreat 2019

1. A $1 / 4$ inch seam is used throughout. Neutral thread would be appreciated.
2. Daw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of 4 " square.

3. With right sides together, align one marked square on the right hand side of the 4 " $\times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown. Stitch on the marked line.

4. Trim $1 / 4 / 4$ from stitched line. Press open with seam allowance towards the triangle.

5. Repeat steps 2 and 3 on the left side o the rectangle.

6. You have now completed the roof unit of the house block.

7. Take $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ door fabric and piece it to the $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square. Press seam towards the square.

8. Add a $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " wall panel to each side of the previously assembled door. Press seams to the outside of the bock.

9. Take the house base unit and roof unit. Join pieces together, pressing seam away from the roof.
