## BoM for January 2022: Two from One

Idea based on a free pattern from https://www.fatquartershop.com/media/wysiwyg/pdf/LayersofCharm.pdf We are using two identical donated Moda fabric Layer Cakes (10" square) and a variety of plains from the CQ stash ( $5^{\prime \prime}$ square).

## Piecing Instructions

NB: When sewing with a "pinked edge" the true $10 \times 10$ is measured at the tip of the pinking

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 5 " charm squares.
2. With right sides facing, lay a 5 " square on one corner of a 10 " square. (NB: the 'pinked edge tip' will be just covered / line up exactly with the solid edge of the plain.)
3. Stitch on the drawn line
4. To make a bonus half square triangle (HST): Draw a second line a $1 / 2$ " away from the stitched line.

5. Stitch on that second drawn line
6. Cut between the two stitched lines to separate the blocks - leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each one
7. Repeat the above steps with the second 5 " square on the diagonally opposite corner
8. For both blocks, gently set, then press seams towards the patterned fabric. (ie avoid the risk of stretching the bias seams with a sliding ironing movement)
