## Chandelier Block - Gwen Parry

Free pattern designed by Lella Boutique. There is a very good YouTube presentation by Missouri Star Quilt Company. This is a very easy block to sew but when set on point it makes an interesting quilt top. Very good pattern for charm squares or for a scrappy quilt.

Your kit contains enough fabric to make 2 blocks to make efficient use of fabric. Use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam throughout.

1. Cut the coloured pieces into 3 accurate $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
2. Cross cut one of the $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares into 4 accurate $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
3. Cut the white into 4 rectangles $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ and 4 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$.
4. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square onto one end of each 7 " rectangle.
5. Sew $5^{\prime \prime}$ strips onto the left and rights sides of both $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
6. Sew the 7" strips onto the top and bottom of the 5 " squares with the coloured squares at opposite corners.

Completed fabric block should be approx. 9", but do NOT trim the block.
